Rooms will not be available for booking until at least the new year. A notification will go out to all registered attendees once arrangements are completed with the hotel. Said announcement will provide reservation timelines, room options and available services.



All participants will be expected to arrive no later than Friday September 24th. Hotel registrations normally open about 3:00 PM. There will be a general orientation meeting the evening of the 24th at the hotel. Time and specific location will be announced separately.

The tour will consist of two driving days, the Saturday & the Sunday. Routes will be available via GPX files off the website and via paper handouts at the orientation session.
