

Southampton and Lake Huron Lighthouse Tour

Start June 13th 9:30 a.m. departure from McDonalds restaurant 23 Broadway Ave. (North of Hwy 9 and Hwy 10), Orangeville.

- Bruce County Museum & Cultural Centre (33 Victoria Street North) is recommended. Replica of the brig HMS General Hunter war of 1812 is featured.
- Two hour Chantry Island Lighthouse Tour
- Southampton Market, indoor, Hwy 21 South
- Ride the S.S. Trolley via scenic route to Port Elgin
- Canoe/kayak on the Saugeen River
- Public Golf Courses, or
- Walk or sit on the beach and enjoy Lake Huron.

Evening - watch the sun set over Lake Huron. Day one ends

Start June 14th 8:30 a.m. departure to OPG's (Ontario Power Generation's) Bruce Power plant via back roads.

A two part presentation at the Bruce Power Visitor Centre deals with:

- 1. Nuclear Power Generation and,
- 2. the evolution of engines leading to the development of turbines. One such diesel engine (perhaps sold by Pat's dad) will be on display.

Following the presentation, a bus tour around the plant is scheduled. They get credit for the number of people that participate in this tour. **PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED TO BOARD THE BUS** (Driver's License or Passport)

Tour Continues - we depart for Kincardine via back roads where we have a brief stop.

We continue on Shoreline Road to 10th Line then Highway 21 en route to a

Cheese Factory. Visit the Pine River Cheese Factory. Leaving the cheese factory we

Point Clark where we will visit the historic lighthouse, one of the first on the Great Lakes.

Homeward Bound via Bruce County roads 2, 21, 6, and Grey 9 to Dundalk where the tour ends at the Tim Horton's / gas station at county road 9 and Highway 10 **or** optionally take twisties to Creemore or follow Highway 10 to Orangeville.






The Southampton Marine Heritage Society invites you on a journey to Chantry Island aboard the *Peerless II* Tour Boat.

The 2 hour excursion includes a return trip from Southampton Harbour to Chantry Island and a guided tour of the restored Keeper's Cottage, gardens, boathouse and the Imperial Lighthouse Tower (a climb of 106 steps to the top).

The tour is much like a medium hike and requires a degree of agility and fitness. Children must be 4 feet (122 cm) tall and all passengers must have proper footwear (running shoes, hiking sandals) - both are mandatory requirements.

Tours run from the end of May till mid-September.
