Friday, May 18, 2018 – in Lake Placid
EARLY BIRD TOUR
(For those who arrive in Lake Placid Thursday afternoon ONLY)

Tom Brown is hosting a ride for early arrivals - departing Friday morning from the Lake House.

Tom says: *The Friday ride has become known as the “early bird tour”, but this year it could be called the “not so early bird tour”, as we will be departing the hotel at 9:45 AM. Depending on group size we will travel as one large group or if need dictates we will break into two smaller groups. That decision will be a parking lot decision prior to departure. Total driving time today to our lunch stop will be 2hr 20min. Driving time back to the hotel following lunch is just about 30 minutes. As you are about to notice, and this is important, there are very, very few good bio-break locations in the Adirondacks, and what there are, are generally one-holers that ladies and gents will have to share. Today, our one and **only** bio break location will be 40 minutes into the ride, so plan around that. Our lunch location can be easy to miss so be careful as you get close; if you cross the train tracks you’ve gone too far. I’ll elaborate in the pre-ride briefing. We are lunching at **Charlie’s Inn, 44 Junction RD, Lake Clear, NY**. Nothing fancy here folks, Charlie’s was chosen as our lunch location because it is old time Adirondacks. The food is decent but it’s the authentic atmosphere that stands out. During the 1980 Olympic Games I worked as an Air Traffic Controller at the temporary control tower set up at the local airport. The housing that I and the other five controllers were provided was right here at Charlie’s. I lived here for about 6 weeks and can say with certainty that **NOTHING** has changed since then, and even then it was looking a bit dated. After lunch it’s a short trip back to the hotel and you’re on your own for the afternoon.*
