The Auberge

You won't need to bring much. The rooms have all you need for a comfortable stay and yes, they do vary in size and style.

They have a games room, weight room (where I'll be @ 4am before my morning jog) and yes Rod, a very neat pool. Indoor Outdoor parking is available complete with a hose to wash your car...They know us so well.

One more thing,

You can bring your own booze. Please ensure that these are concealed in a bag if you know what I mean. They don't want to advertise it.

Check in, Relax and we'll see you on the mezzanine located above the pool.

Friday Aug 4th. Travel to Orford. **Load GPX File "Orford 2017" and pick the appropriate route**

1. No group travel from home will be organized this year. The 3 exits are Sorel-Sherbrooke and St Benoit,
2. The drive to Orford is very simple. 401 East changes to Autoroute 20 in Quebec Keep right.
3. I would strongly recommend avoiding the intersection of Autoroute 30 and 10 during rush hour. If you do get into bumper to bumper traffic rest assured, it picks up quite nicely down the road. Be courteous and let the traffic merge.
4. Note: Autoroute 30 is a new detour road around Montreal and may not show up on your GPS
5. Watch your speed especially on Autoroute-30. Follow the flow.
6. Jackie and I are figuring on an 8-hour drive from Georgetown including (2) stops.

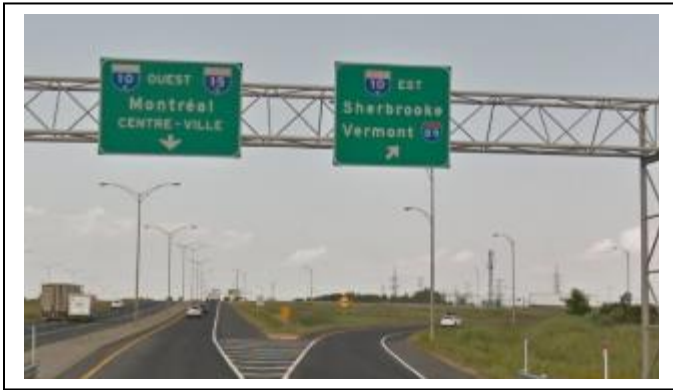
Exit 29 Autoroute 30 towards Sorel



Keep Right Exit 29 Autoroute 30 towards Sorel EST (\$2.80Toll Bridge). Take Exit 67 Towards Sherbrooke



Follow 10 EST Sherbrooke



In About 100km from 30. Exit 115



Turn right at the stop on chemin Milletta.

This is your opportunity to gas up and get some booze at the Couche Tard convenience store on your right.

Take the 3rd Exit on the first roundabout (Orford)



Take the 2nd exit on the second roundabout (Orford)



2 minutes up Chemin du Mont Orford and you have arrived.



Dinner,

Nothing has been planned for tonight. You have options on site with some fine dining or the famous Burger pub. You can also search the web for some restaurants in Magog and there are plenty of them to choose from.

Breakfast,

The package includes 2 hot buffet breakfasts. When you use them will be up to you. Keep in mind that the Sunday Train and Boat tour will be serving Brunch.

Saturday Aug 5th (GPX Saturday Cheezie Tour)

Train and Boat Tours (GPX Orford to Parking)

1. The Train departs @ 10:00am and Boat depart @ 11:00am.
2. See the roster sheet to figure out which one you chose.
3. The Parking lot is 10 minutes away located at [345 rue du Moulin](#), Magog. The cost is \$7/Car CASH
GPS available. Head South out of the Hotel (Left) Through both roundabouts onto 112 towards Magog. Turn left on Rue Du Moulin after the train tracks. Look for the parking lot on the Left past the red Brick Building.

The Train

Meet up with Pat Sullivan in parking lot at 9:00am. Leave by 9:15am. Stay as a group upon arrival in the parking lot and Follow the path to the ticket office by 9:30am and pick up your tickets. The Train departs @ 10:00am.

The Boat

Meet up with Bernie in the Parking lot at 10:00am. Leave by 10:15am. Stay as a group upon arrival in the parking lot and Follow the path to the ticket office by 10:30am and pick up your tickets. The Train departs @ 11:00am.

Early Dinner (GPX Sunday Lac Brompton)
