1. GPX 2015 HP-Vermont-Smug Yes (or No)

Port Hope Comfort-Inn to Vermont

The reference to "Smug Yes" or "Smug No" for both GPX and map files is whether or not Smugglers notch will be open. This was unknown at the time of mapping the tour.

First group Departs Comfort Inn @ 8:00 am. (Drivers meeting at 7:30) using Telephone Road directly behind the hotel and then linking up to the 401.

Stops

- En route 401 gas and Timmy's Prior to Kingston. Waypoint #4
- Ogdensburg Border. I didn't account for Duty Free Waypoint #5
- Lunch. Town of Potsdam at the Village Diner Waypoint #8
- Gas Hwy-11 & I-89 before Champlain NY Waypoint #11
- Stowehof Inn Waypoint #17
- Total travel time is 8.5 Hrs

2. GPX 2015 Friday-Early Bird

Stowehof-Inn south circle tour

First group departs @ 10:00 am. (Drivers meeting at 9:30)

Stops

- One lunch stop in Richmond Waypoint #11
- Total travel time is +- 4 Hrs

3. GPX 2015 Saturday Spring Tour

Stowehof-Inn West to Lake Champlain Islands

First group departs @ 9:00 am. (Drivers meeting at 8:30)

Stops

- Bio Break at Mobil Station Waypoint #8
- Short Ice cream, Bio and gift shop break at Hero's Welcome. Waypoint #30
- Burlington Parking on King St. for lunch and shopping. Waypoint #40
- No return Map. Take 89 S to exit 10 (Vermont 100) Waterbury/Stowe

4. GPX 2015 Sunday Full Circle

Stowehof-Inn West to the bottom end of Champlain

First group departs @ 9:00 am. (Drivers meeting at 8:30)

Stops

- Bio Break at CITCO Waypoint #11
- Lunch, Main Street in Bristol Waypoint #21
- Total travel time is +- 5Hrs 30 min.

- 1. The PDF maps found on the web site are for your use and up to you to print should you choose to use them.
- 2. Fuel up the night before the tour(s).
- 3. Follow proper touring etiquette.
- 4. Smugglers Notch intersection below as seen travelling on 15 East on Friday. <u>Keep right onto</u> 108 S if the Notch is open.



5. You might see some wigglies on your GPS form time to time. Not all units are configured the same. Don't worry and don't follow then into the cow pasture.



6. Please also remove all avoidances from your GPS so that everyone is on the same page as shown below.
