

Participation Drive - Trillium Miata/MX5

Introduction

This drive is a combination of turn by turn directions, questions about the drive and brain teaser questions all printed on paper and given to each participating car at the start of the drive. No digital or electronic or internet devices allowed (including CB radios). Unless you are lost and need them to get to the Finish location.

There is also a Poker Run included and the direction will guide you to where you pick-up each of the 5 playing cards you need for your poker hand.

All cars will start from the same location with 5 cars leaving at the same time BUT each of these cars will have a different set of directions. The set you receive will be identified as Group One or Group Two or Group Three or Group Four or Group Five. Every three minutes we will send out 5 cars (one from each group) until all cars have left the starting location. The five sets of directions are only different for the first 14 or so Kms. Then everyone is on the same route for the balance of the drive, this is done to get away from the start point quicker when we have a lot of participants.

NOTE:- the DIRECTIONS use CUMULATIVE MILEAGES, so you MUST ZERO your TRIP ODOMETER at the start.

NOTE:- this is **NOT a Convoy** you must follow your own set of directions.

The "direction package" given to you at the start will have the route (turn by turn) directions printed in blue, the drive questions you are to answer printed in green, the poker run locations printed in black. All of these activities are located at the proper interval along the route. Please write your answers beside the questions .

At the back of the direction package is a list of brain teaser questions, printed in red, please write your answer beside the question. You can do these questions anytime during the drive.

At the end of the drive you must hand in your completed direction package and 5 card poker hand. In the days to follow the drive we will determine the prize winners and let the participants know .

There are no time and distance points awarded so this drive can be completed following lawful driving practices.

The drive is easier with a navigator but with time and caution can be done by a driver alone.

The finish location has food available, but bringing your own food and picnic is not.

Please arrive at the start location with the gas tank full and bladders empty.

Now you know why it is called a Participation Drive.
